Read this information carefully before you start using **ANDOLEX WILDBERRY PASTILLES**. **DO NOT THROW THIS LEAFLET AWAY!** It contains important information. If you have any questions about **ANDOLEX WILDBERRY PASTILLES** please ask your healthcare provider.

What is **ANDOLEX WILDBERRY PASTILLES** and what is it used for

- **ANDOLEX WILDBERRY PASTILLES** is a Medical Device which contains Ectoin[®], a natural cell-protective molecule with inflammation-reducing and membrane-stabilizing properties.
- **ANDOLEX WILDBERRY PASTILLES** are pastilles for the treatment and prevention of dry mouth and throat, and hoarseness due to voice overuse.
- **ANDOLEX WILDBERRY PASTILLES** forms a protective shield called "Ectoin[®] Hydro Complex" on mucous membranes in the mouth and throat without leaving a slimy feeling.
- Irritations of mucous membranes, such as voice fatigue, tickly throat, or dryness caused by voice overuse, allergens or dry air from e. g. heating, cold air, air conditioning or smoke, can be prevented and reduced.
- **ANDOLEX WILDBERRY PASTILLES** hydrates dry and irritated mucous membranes and supports their regeneration.
- **ANDOLEX WILDBERRY PASTILLES** has a mild and pleasant wildberry and menthol flavour and is free of preservatives.

Warnings and precautions

- **ANDOLEX WILDBERRY PASTILLES** should not be used during persisting traumas, e. g. after surgery or injuries of the mouth.
- Children younger than 6 years should not use **ANDOLEX WILDBERRY PASTILLES** due to danger of suffocation (potential choking hazard).
- Do not use the pastilles while lying down, e.g. at bedtime, due to the risk of choking.
- Do not use pastilles from damaged or punctured blisters.

What you need to know before using **ANDOLEX WILDBERRY PASTILLES**

There are no data available on interactions between **ANDOLEX WILDBERRY PASTILLES** and other pastilles. Please ask your healthcare provider or pharmacist for advice before using other medicines or medical devices.

What should be noted during pregnancy and while breast-feeding

Currently, there are no data available regarding the use of **ANDOLEX WILDBERRY PASTILLES** during pregnancy and while breast-feeding. Consult your healthcare provider or pharmacist for advice, before using this Medical Device, if you are:

- pregnant or breast-feeding
- not sure whether you are pregnant or not

How to use **ANDOLEX WILDBERRY PASTILLES**

The pastille should be dissolved slowly in the mouth.

1-2 pastilles should be sucked slowly every 3 hours or as often as needed.

ANDOLEX WILDBERRY PASTILLES should not be used in the case of hypersensitivity to Ectoin[®] or any of the other ingredients of the pastilles. If allergic reactions occur, the use of **ANDOLEX WILDBERRY PASTILLES** must be discontinued immediately.

Possible side effects of ANDOLEX WILDBERRY PASTILLES

ANDOLEX WILDBERRY PASTILLES is well tolerated. Up to now, no regularly occurring or persisting side effects are known. If used excessively, a slight laxative effect can occur very rarely, due to the ingredients sorbitol and maltitol. Please inform your healthcare provider if you notice side effects that are associated with the use of ANDOLEX WILDBERRY PASTILLES. If conditions persist or worsen, contact your healthcare provider or pharmacist.

How to store ANDOLEX WILDBERRY PASTILLES

ANDOLEX WILDBERRY PASTILLES should be stored out of the reach of children and between 2 °C – 25 °C in a dry place. The expiry date of

ANDOLEX WILDBERRY PASTILLES is printed on the box and on the blister.

Do not use ANDOLEX WILDBERRY PASTILLES after the expiry date.

Blister packs with 10 pastilles each.

Each 1 g pastille contains: Ectoin[®] 10 mg
Contains sugar: Sorbitol 0,1 g, maltitol 0,422 g
Contains sweetener: Acesulfame K 0,001 g
Other ingredients include: Wildberry Flavour, Menthol, Grape Skin Extract, Citric Acid, Gum Arabic, Water, Vegetable Oil and Beeswax.

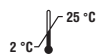
